

Installation of $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}_{\text{MACS}}$ on Windows XP and Cygwin

Warning 1. You need 1giga of memory.

Note 2. This installation procedure works probably with other versions of Windows, but we did not test it.

Remark 3. Why install $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}_{\text{MACS}}$ in a Microsoft environment? This is not a support to a company which refuses to give its knowledge to the public, but 99% of computers work with its operating systems, thats is a fact.

Warning 4. The previous remark is only the opinion of its author.

1 Binary installation.

It consists in a compressed file `TeXmacs.zip`. Install its files and directory under C:

cygwin

a complete installation of Cygwin (1giga)

.bashrc

set the environment variable PATH.

.bash_profile

set variables for the Web. Modify them for your environment.

.fvwm

configuration of the window manager for the the X11 environemnt where $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}_{\text{MACS}}$ works.

TeXmacs-installation

contains the document that you are reading, in format ps, pdf and $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}_{\text{MACS}}$.

TeXmacs_script

auxiliary file

TeXmacs.bat

the short-cut launching $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}_{\text{MACS}}$

When these files and directories are installed, launch $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}_{\text{MACS}}$ whith the short-cut.
